

THE BEN HOLLAND MEMORIAL PHOTO COMPETITION 2018

RULES, TERMS & CONDITIONS

When

All photographs entered into the Ben Holland Memorial Photo Competition 2018 must have been taken at the Nile River Festival 2018, between January 25th and January 28th 2018.

Submissions will be taken from January 25th 00:01 to February 4th 23:59.

Who may enter

Anyone in attendance of the Nile River Festival 2018 is welcome to enter the Ben Holland Memorial Photo Competition for free.

What to enter

An image that tells the story of the Nile River Festival (the successes, the fears, the parties, the fun, the epic kayaking etc).

Cropped photos are eligible in all categories. We do not accept digitally or otherwise enhanced or altered photos. Minor adjustments, including spotting, dodging and burning, sharpening, contrast and slight colour adjustment or the digital equivalents, are acceptable.

Photos that contain sexually explicit, nude, obscene, violent or other objectionable or inappropriate content, as determined by the judging panel in its sole discretion, are ineligible for this contest.

How to enter

Entries should be posted on Facebook and Instagram with #NileRiverFest included in the post.

High-quality scans of non-digital photographs are acceptable. Digital photographs should be taken at the highest resolution possible.

You retain the rights to your photograph; however, by entering the contest, you grant Kayak the Nile (and those authorised by Kayak the Nile) a royalty-free, world-wide, perpetual, non-exclusive license to; publicly display, distribute, reproduce and create derivative works of the entries, in whole or in part, in any media now existing or later developed, for any Kayak the Nile purpose, including, but not limited to, advertising and promotion of Kayak the Nile and its website, social media and commercial products.

Any photograph reproduced will include a photographer credit where feasible. Kayak the Nile will not be required to pay any additional consideration or seek any additional approval in connection with such uses.

Judging

For the people's choice award, the winner will be decided according to the most liked image on either Facebook or Instagram.

For the judges' choice award, photos will be judged on originality, technical excellence, composition, overall impact, artistic merit and subject matter relevance to the categories. We want to see images that tell the stories of the Nile River Festival (the successes, the fears, the parties, the fun, the epic kayaking and more).

Judging will be conducted by the judges selected by Kayak the Nile (a panel of photographers with experience of the water sport and outdoor industry).

A selection of finalists will be announced and displayed on the Kayak the Nile Facebook page on/by February 11th.

The winners will be notified via email/direct message on/by February 11th.

If one image holds particular merit, it could win both prizes.

Prizes

The festival is running on a much tighter budget than ever before and while we will strive to ensure there is a cash prize for both awards, it cannot be guaranteed and may be replaced with other equally desirable prizes. We hope to be able to award a minimum of:

\$50 cash prize for the people's choice

\$50 cash prize for the judges' choice

Conditions of Entry

All entrants hold the event organisers (Kayak the Nile) and its sponsors and their respective directors, employees, interns, and volunteers (the "Indemnified Parties") harmless from and against all claims of any nature arising in connection with entrant's participation in the contest and acceptance or use of a prize. The Indemnified Parties are not liable for any costs, damages, injuries, or other claims incurred as a result of entrants' participation in the contest or winner's acceptance and usage of a prize. The Indemnified Parties are not responsible for incomplete or misdirected entries, technical or network malfunctions or failures, or

causes beyond their control. Entrants are solely responsible for their entries.

Any prize money not collected in person may be transferred at the organiser's/Kayak the Nile's discretion, but the fees for such a transfer must be covered from the prize money.

Entrants may not submit materials that introduce any software viruses, worms or other programmes designed to damage software, hardware or telecommunications equipment or are off-topic, partisan-political, contain advertising, nudity, personal attacks or expletives, or is otherwise abusive, threatening, unlawful, harassing, discriminatory, libellous, obscene, false, sexually explicit, or that infringes on the rights of any third party.

The contest is void where prohibited or restricted by law. Kayak the Nile reserves the right to cancel the contest or modify these rules at its discretion. In the event of a dispute regarding the winners, Kayak the Nile reserves the right to award or not award the prizes in its sole discretion. Kayak the Nile reserves the right to disqualify any entrant whose entry or conduct appears in any way to: inhibit the enjoyment of others; tamper with the competition; violate these rules or other applicable law or regulation; infringe on the rights of third parties; or act in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner.

Kayak the Nile reserves the right to cancel the contest should no more than 3 participants enter the event.

Decisions of the event organisers/Kayak the Nile are final and binding.
