All spectator transport is 10,000 ugx per person each direction - this will be collected prior to departure. Tickets are available to buy at registration & from the KTN office at Nile River Explorers Campsite. Return transport must be booked and paid for by the morning of the event at the latest. If you prefer, you are welcome to arrange your own transport down to the event site. Please be aware the event sites are basic and have limited shade – bring your suncream/water/hats etc. The shuttle buses will not depart until the end of the day's event and will not leave until they are full.

Journey time: 45 minutes.

Evening: The main Nile River Festival party – do not miss one of Uganda's biggest parties of the year! Nile River Explorers Bar – Jelly wrestling, live music and a whole heap of fun! Don't miss it!
